Thomas Edison was one of the most important inventors in our history. He was born in Ohio, USA, in 1847. He used to be a very curious child, therefore he had problems at school. At the age of 22 he moved to New York and started selling his first inventions. With this money, he created his lab in Merlo Park. There he patented more important discoveries like the phonograph, the new telegraph system, a very important version of the light bulb or the kinetoscope. During his life, he patented more than one thousand inventions. He was known as the Wizard of Merlo Park.
